Job Description

Garden and Grounds Assistant

- Intern will work closely with the gardener and act as liaison between garden and kitchen
- Help with guest volunteer's working in the garden
- The intern will often be asked to work outdoors and should be comfortable using hand tools such as shovels, clippers and the like.
- Tidy the grounds-putting playground equipment away, sweeping, raking, etc
- Job will require harvesting from the garden and candidate will lift 25-40lbs on occasion.
- Interns will also help set up tables and chairs for retreats, workshops and special events.
- Intern will be supervised by Gardener, Maintenance Manager and the Executive Director

Wellspring is a non-profit, inter-faith retreat center in Philo. Interns should be prepared to deal with a wide variety of guests and at certain times will have a great deal of guest contact. We are part of a land conservation trust and part of our mission as a non-profit is sustainability and stewardship of the land. We have 53 acres with the Navarro River running through the middle and a large organic garden.

Hours: The intern can negotiate their schedule and number of hours will vary weekly. We ask that all staff be prepared to work some weekend shifts.
